Greetings in the name of the Lord Jesus!

I am reminded of something that happened many years ago at a conference when we were still living in Sweden. The Holy Ghost came over me, and I began to weep. My heart was breaking, and I could not stop. The meeting ended, and everyone went home, but I stayed on, still weeping. The Norwegian preacher, Age Aleskjaer, who had preached that night asked

me, "Christopher, what is it that you want from God?" Something arose from the depths of my heart, and I cried out, "I want to win a million souls for Jesus!" That was all I wanted; to be able to win a million souls for Jesus within my lifetime.

Zomba, Malawi Update:

This year has been a wonderful year for us. We have seen over a million people receive the Lord Jesus at our 2005 crusades!

We first started our African crusades in Malawi, which is located in South-Central Africa. It is one of the poorest nations on the earth. In 1988, we held a

crusade in the city of Zomba. At that time, forty percent of Zomba's population was Muslim. The Lord did a mighty work during that crusade, and we planted a church which today has more than 2000 people in attendance. Since that time, this church has gone on to plant over 25 churches in neighboring communities and villages!

The 2005 crusade was well-prepared by our director, Pastor Mavondo, and our Africa team. There was tremendous expectation and excitement at the start of the

crusade. Multitudes of people came out to hear the Gospel each evening, and many responded to the altar calls to receive Jesus as their Lord and Savior.

During the crusade, God also confirmed His Word with many signs, wonders, and miracles. Among them there were lame people who can now walk and dance, blind eyes that can now see, and deaf-mutes who are able to hear and speak.

One night, when the power of God fell upon the crowd, a crippled man was healed. He started to walk, then with a huge smile on his face he began to dance. His wife, who had brought him to the meeting, also began danc-

ing holding his crutches aloft like trophies. The crowd came unglued with sheer joy and began dancing and shouting. In addition to this wonderful miracle, a deaf-mute child began to hear and speak, and many deaf people were healed.

On another night, there was an incredible and outstanding miracle. An insane man was brought to the crusade by his son. He had suddenly lost his mind in 1982. He did not know who or where he was. He did not recognize anyone, not even his family. In addition, he had lost his speech and had not spoken in the past 23 years. He was totally vegetative and incommunicable. That night, Jesus touched him! He was instantly delivered, and he began to smile. He soon began to talk and converse! What a wonderful Jesus we serve! Who can do such things but Jesus?

God also touched many others that night. Two blind women were healed. A girl who was born a deaf-mute and a boy

who became a deaf-mute after suffering from meningitis were both healed. A little boy who had never stood or walked stood up for the first time and walked! There were also large tumors that disappeared, and many deaf people were healed.

On the last night, we saw thousands of people receive the Lord Jesus. After that, I prepared to pray for people to receive the Baptism with the Holy Ghost and with Fire. Several thousand got ready to receive. I gave a short two-minute teaching and went to my knees to pray for them. Before I could begin praying, the Holy Ghost suddenly came upon the crowd like a mighty tidal wave of Glory. People began to speak in other tongues. Wave after wave of Glory came until the whole field

was covered with Pentecostal Fire.

From the platform, I looked out over the beautiful mass of tear streaked African faces with their hands raised in the air. The sound was like that of a hundred waterfalls as they continued speaking in other tongues. Many people were shaking, shouting, and falling to the ground. The Presence of the Lord was amazing. We could not stop worshipping God. The praise, worship, and adoration of the multitude rose up in waves into the clear African sky. God's Healing power then came over the people and immensely large numbers

of people were healed. Deafness, blindness, paralysis, injuries, tumors, and diseases disappeared under the mighty Name of the Lord Jesus.

The crusade concluded with the multitudes of people singing, dancing, and praising God, sending large clouds of dust into the air. As I rejoiced along with the people, I reveled in the sweet scent of the African dust, and thought about how much I love that smell and how much I love these people. I love every inch of soil in places like Africa and Asia; that love is branded into my heart. Jesus loves these precious people, and He rejoices when they receive and worship Him. He paid the price for their salvation, and we shall not stop until the last one is set free from the powers of darkness and brought to the feet of the Savior.

As we gather together to celebrate Christmas, let us look past the decorations, the gifts under the trees, and the crowds at the mall, and remember our Lord Jesus who came to this world to save sinners. This is what Christmas is all about; the celebration of our blessed Savior.
