God Made A Way In Luveve!

Dear Friends,

Greetings in Jesus Name!

I trust you have had a blessed Christmas and New Year together with your families, friends, and loved ones. As for us, we ended 2007 thankful and rejoicing over all the wonderful things the Lord did during the year. We then entered into 2008 with our hearts filled with great expectations of what the Lord will do this year!

In this newsletter, I want to share about a School of Ministry and crusade that we recently held in Luveve, Zimbabwe.

The Lord has directed us to hold 3 such large Schools of Ministry in Africa every year, where we can train and equip ministers to do the work of the Gospel more effectively.

The fact that we could hold this School

of Ministry was, in itself, quite a feat. We envisioned 1000 pastors attending and planned to feed them while they were with us. This gesture would be an added blessing since most of these pastors minister in impoverished areas and often do not get enough to eat due to the tough economic situation in Zimbabwe.

In spite of the acute shortage of food in Zimbabwe, we got together enough chicken, beef, and everything else we needed to make sure that everybody ate well during their time with us. This was a true blessing from God!

Between 700 and 800 pastors attended the School of Ministry. Some could not come because of fuel shortages that had shut down much of the public transportation in Zimbabwe. But those who had faith made it there in spite of adverse circumstances. *"Faith always makes a way"* is something that I have learnt! People came from several African

countries and even from the US and Europe. One group of pastors came from the war zone in Congo. They had heard about the School of Ministry through the "grapevine" and somehow made it all the way to Southern Zimbabwe with very little money in their pockets. They then looked around until they found us!

Speaking with me at the School of Ministry were Pastors Edwin Anderson (High Springs, FL), Dale Armstrong (Lancaster, PA) and Walker Schurz a missionary pastoring in Lusaka, Zambia. These are all friends of mine and very anointed men of God whose churches I have ministered in at different times.

The Word of God went forth with great power. We saw strong moves of the Holy Spirit in the teaching sessions. The pastors testified of the great things that the Lord did in their lives and many signed up to attend the next School of Ministry in March 2008!

In the evenings we also held an open-air Gospel crusade. Unfortunately, the rainy season unexpectedly started a week earlier than usual. Every day, strong storm winds blew over the region along with heavy rains. The winds were so strong that microphone stands and chairs were blown off the platform.

On top of this, the temperature dropped drastically and it became extremely cold in the evenings. It took effort just standing and preaching up on the platform in the cold, hard winds and rain. We pressed on nevertheless, with the exception of one evening when it rained so heavily that we could not even start the service.

The interesting thing is that multitudes of people came to hear the Gospel in spite of these severely adverse weather conditions. God responded to the faith of the people and moved mightily in our midst, and large numbers were saved and healed by His power.

Many people came forward and testified of the miracles that the Lord had done for them. Firstly, there were many deaf people who came up and testified that they had been healed. Some had been deaf in both ears while others had been deaf in one ear only.

There were many others who were healed from many different kinds of other diseases and infirmities. Some of the testimonies really stood out, like

19 year old Primrose Madziro who was lame since birth and could not walk. Her friends had brought her to the crusade where Jesus healed her. She then got up and walked as the crowd cheered and praised God.

Another really outstanding miracle was that which God did for a baby

Thandolowenkosi Mlupi, who was brought to the crusade by her mother. She was born with brain damage. Additionally, she was deaf and paralyzed; unable to move her legs or sit up.

In an instant, God healed this little child. She began to hear and to respond. She could suddenly grasp and hold things with her once useless hands. She sat up and began to move her legs. In other words, she suddenly became a normal and healthy baby! Her mother wept and praised God.

What a wonderful Jesus we serve! His power and His compassion are beyond comprehension!

Then there was 41 year old Mrs. Mabunda who had a severe stroke that had left her deaf and paralyzed in most of her body. She heard of the crusade and wanted to attend, but she had nobody to take her. Nevertheless, she somehow managed to drag her paralyzed body to the crusade. It was extremely difficult, but her faith in Jesus was strong. Jesus healed her and she began to hear and to move freely. She ran, jumped, and danced, as she rejoiced, shouted and praised God.

It is very humbling to see such things because it always reminds me of the fact that people do not get healed in our crusades because of "me" or "my anointing". People get healed because the Spirit of God grabs them, they put their faith in Jesus, and He touches them. Then Jesus says to them, "YOUR faith

has healed you!" You see, it is because of Jesus and Jesus alone.

On the last night, the Holy Ghost fell upon the crowd and many were baptized with the Holy Ghost and with Fire. In spite of the very harsh weather conditions in which we had to conduct the meetings, the crusade, thus, ended with a note of victory!

Ministry Update

TAIWAN

For 9 days I ministered in churches located in three different cities with multiple services each day. Taiwan has very few Christians, and it was amazing to see hundreds coming to the Lord in regular church services. Additionally, the Lord confirmed His Word with signs following: blind eyes began to see, the deaf began to hear, and people with many different diseases and infirmities were healed.

ASIA

I visited our team in Asia, and our churches continue to stand strong in spite of heavy persecution and threats both from local Buddhists and the military authorities. They are preaching the Gospel with signs following: people are coming to Jesus and their churches are growing! We are starting 10 more churches as I write, bringing the total number of churches that we have planted in this nation to 114.

SWITZERLAND and THE NETHERLANDS

I ministered at Zoe Gospel Center in Zurich (Switzerland) pastored by my friend, Pastor Peter Hasler. I also ministered in Maranatha Church in Amsterdam (The Netherlands) pastored by my friend, Pastor Stanley Hofwijks. It was good to be back in these churches, where I am always treated like family. God touched many people in these meetings.

LEBANON

I ministered at the Abundant Life Church pastored by Pastor Chady El Aouad. Many received Jesus and we saw God do many wonderful healings and miracles, especially with deaf people receiving their hearing. I also met with Pastor Walid El-Khoury and we discussed plans to broadcast our Africa crusades (dubbed into Arabic) throughout the Middle-East over his Spirit Channel Satellite TV station. This would be an effective tool in bringing many Arab Muslims to Christ. Additionally, we now have open door to go into Syria!
